Embattled SP shows unity as Mulayam flags off 'Rath Yatra'

Lucknow, 3 November

Putting up a united face amid the ongoing and acrimonious power struggle in the ruling Samajwadi Party (SP) in Uttar Pradesh, party president and patriarch Mulayam Singh Yadav on Thursday flagged off Chief Minister Akhilesh Yadav's much-hyped 'Vikas Rath Yatra'.

Flanked by younger brother Shivpal Singh Yadav, who is locked in a bitter feud with Akhilesh over greater control in the party and government, Mulayam wished success of the Yatra in fetching majority to SP in the 2017 UP polls and retaining power.

However, in his address, Mulayam also struck a note of caution to the youth party cadres, who are predominantly supporting Akhilesh in the widening fissure in SP, to desist from mere slogan shouting and instead read the socialist movement literature to strengthen the party and understand the struggles behind the Samajwadi movement.

Mulayam said SP was a result of sacrifices, struggles and hard work and not slogan shouting. The former defence minister revealed he had advised Akhilesh to name the Yatra as 'Vijay Vikas Rath Yatra' rather than 'Vikas Rath Yatra', but said his suggestion was not conceded to.

Addressing the huge turnout of SP workers at the La Martiniere College Ground here, Akhilesh claimed his government had fulfilled all the promises made in the party manifesto and ushered in balanced development encompassing the rural and urban areas.

He said his government had worked for the betterment of all sections of society without discrimination and the people should judge his performance on the basis of the work.

"This election (UP polls) is not only about UP, but for giving direction to national polity," Akhilesh said making oblique reference to the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) led central government as he raked up the issue of an ex-army personnel's suicide allegedly over the One Rank, One Pension (OROP) scheme.

Like an astute politician and without taking names, Akhilesh alleged conspiracies with vested interests over the past weeks, that had delayed the party's poll campaign. However, he exuded confidence he would return to power with absolute majority as in the 2012 polls.

This is the party's fourth Rath Yatra in its about 25 years of existence, of which Akhilesh had led three, while one was led by Mulayam.

Putting to rest the speculation whether Akhilesh would participate in the silver jubilee foundation day function slated for November 5 here, the CM confirmed he would be a part and urged the youth cadres to make both the programmes successful.

Meanwhile, Akhilesh's Rath developed a technical snag soon after the Yatra had entered the 23-km long Shaheed Path for its journey from Lucknow to Unnao, forcing the CM to continue the journey in his accompanying official car.

Earlier, Shivpal also wished Akhilesh success in his Rath Yatra, saying he hoped it would help the party's aim of stopping BJP from coming to power in the state.

The Yatra, which marks the blowing of the poll bugle by Akhilesh, is a mass contact programme to propagate his development projects and schemes.

It has been organised at a time, when SP is also trying to sew an alliance with 'like minded' parties to keep BJP at bay.

The Yatra is being managed by Akhilesh's close confidante and member of legislative council Sunil Yadav Sajjan from the newly inaugurated Janeshwar Mishra Trust, which is the 'war room' of the CM for the forthcoming polls.

Given the mounting electricity bills and the fact that there has been no fare revision in the past seven years, Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) is headed for a bumpy ride. DMRC last revised fares in September 2009 when the minimum fare was raised to ₹8 from ₹6 earlier and maximum to ₹30 from ₹22.

Since then, the cost of electricity has gone up manifold. Cost of per-unit power in 2009-10 was ₹3.21, which doubled to ₹7.25 a unit in 2015-16. DMRC's energy expenditure in 2009-10 was ₹83.2 crore, which rose to a whopping ₹520.5 crore in 2015-16. DMRC consumes 65 per cent of energy for traction with 35 per cent consumed by other auxiliary services for various passenger facilities such as air conditioning, lighting, fire and hydraulics, lift escalators, etc.

Expenditure towards energy constitutes 38 per cent of DMRC's total operational expenses. DMRC, which suffered a net loss of ₹708.5 crore in 2015-16, has the liability of returning interest on loan, return of the principal and depreciation.

More than the losses, it is the burgeoning operating ratio that is a bigger cause of worry for DMRC. Its operating ratio was 54.8 per cent in

2009-10, which moved up to 69.4 per cent in 2015-16. With the increase in network size and commuters, DMRC's expenses have also risen exponentially. To curtail the expenses, especially on electricity, the corporation has switched to solar power and even set up solar panels to generate energy.

Currently, it is running trains in energy-saving mode, de-energising the idle trains, optimising the air-conditioning levels, etc. But, these efforts might not be sufficient to sustain operations going forward, said an official. According to sources, DMRC is also taking steps to cut costs by rationalising staff expenses. Mechanised cleaning is being promoted to curtail staff on cleaning head.

Expansion of its fleet of coaches is another inevitable part of DMRC and it is an ongoing process. DMRC has added 1,020 coaches since 2009-10 and 258 new ones will be added by December 2017.

"We plan to add 916 coaches over the next six months. We need money for that - each coach costs ₹10 crore. With the existing funds we can only maintain the current lot of coaches," a DMRC official told Business Standard.

The predicted ridership of Delhi Metro, often described as the national capital's lifeline, for the current year is 2.7 million passengers a day.

Odisha approves its first private industrial park

A state level committee headed by the chief secretary on Thursday approved in principle the first private industrial park in Odisha. The park will be established by Gitanjali Gems at Ramdaspur in the Cuttack district.

Around ₹700 crore would be invested on the park in next seven years. It is planned on 100 acres of land. Gitanjali Gems had proposed to set up a gems and jewellery processing unit during discussions with an Odisha delegation at the 'Make in India' week held in Mumbai this year in February. Following up on its proposal, the company submitted its application which the State Level Single Window Clearance Authority had approved in May 2016. The park is expected to provide thrust to the export oriented gems & jewellery sector of eastern India in general and Odisha in particular.

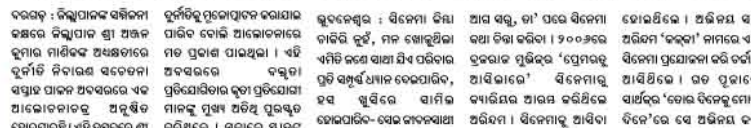
